### **Introduction**

In this life we will all face **new realities**. If you want to enjoy the **path to peace** given by God, we must learn to accept our **new reality**.

**Saul's acceptance** of his **new reality** is guaranteed because of the **effectual call**. Effectual call refers to God's specific and powerful summons. This call leads to salvation and ultimately to the work one has been called to do.

### **The Lesson**

#### **I. The Introduction of God to Saul**

- a. Look at the “**first Lord**” in verse 5 and the “**first Lord**” in verse 6. These two do not have the same meaning, why?
