Open It

- I. Why not ask! What do you want to do for the Lord? What is required for you to do it? Once you discover what it is you want to do, ask for what you need. It is very important that your request is not of a "selfish" **nature**". When we hear others asking for God to do something, to give them something it could sound **selfish.** However, we don't always know why they are asking for what they are asking for. Why not ask.
- II. What do you need to enhance your ministry for the Lord? What are you going to do with what you are asking God for? If He give it to you, how does it benefit the kingdom of God?
- III. From both the context and results of Jabez's prayer, we can see that there was more to his request than a simple desire for more real estate. He wanted more influence, more responsibility, and more opportunity to make a mark for the God of Israel. What is embedded in your request? Why not ask.
