Open It

- I. The word bypass means to go around, avoid, circumvent. Read John 14:6. Now, this is clear language, how do we reconcile all of those faiths who pray but bypass Jesus? Does God hear them? Yes! But there is more to the story.
- II. Prayer is for believers only. It is not for the heathen. It is not for the atheist. It is not for the good person who, nevertheless, regards Jesus as nothing more than a man, with little more than an example. In other words, we do not need to pray **through** Jesus, this was just an example of how to pray.
